Franz-Josef-Land in Wien: Hier werden historisch ausgedehnte Sprachgrenzen wieder ineinander geschränkt, indem Versatzstücke historischer Kartenausschnitte, die heute so abstrakt wirken wie die Schollen am Polarkreis, in den urbanen Raum der Gegenwart gelegt werden. Die Bild-Text-Setzung mit Landkartausschnitten und Rissen eröffnet weitere Bedeutungsräume für die verzeichneten Namen und die sie umgebenden kartografischen Linien, Flächen und Farben.

Franz-Josef Land in Vienna: Austria's historic language boundaries are overlaid against one another in the contemporary urban space. The combination of text and image and cutting extends the semantic space of names indicated along with the cartographical lines, surfaces, and colors that surround them.
